## ***What Is It?***

Putnam County Development Authority is partnering with its Advantage Valley partners as well as the RCBI Institute for Advanced Manufacturing to host the Healthcare Supply Chain Expo featuring Charleston Area Medical Center and Mountain Health Network. We invite you to join us, as company representatives meet to talk about supplier opportunities, supply and service needs and vendor and purchasing requirements for suppliers throughout the region hoping to do business with area healthcare providers.

Charleston Area Medical Center (CAMC) is a nonprofit, 956-bed, regional referral center with nearly 8,000 employees and more than 700 physicians with admitting privileges. CAMC is home to a cancer program that has been continuously accredited since 1947; the center is home to one of the top heart programs in the United States; the first kidney transplant center in the state; West Virginia's first free-standing Women and Children's Hospital; the highest level new born intensive care unit, highest level pediatric intensive care unit and one of the busiest Level I Trauma Centers.

Mountain Health Network is a West Virginia-based not-for-profit health delivery system comprised of Cabell Huntington Hospital, a 303-bed teaching hospital for Marshall University Schools of Medicine, Pharmacy and Nursing; St. Mary's Medical Center, a 393-bed teaching hospital that operates St. Mary's Schools of Nursing, Respiratory Care and Medical Imaging; Hoops Family Children Hospital, a 72-bed pediatric specialty hospital within Cabell Huntington Hospitals; HIMG, a 60-member multi-specialty physician group; and a management agreement with Pleasant Valley Hospital, a 101 acute-bed hospital. Mountain Health is committed to improving the health and well-being of over one million children and adults in 23 counties in West Virginia, Southern Ohio and eastern Kentucky through understanding, respecting and meeting their needs.

The virtual event is free and open to area businesses. It will take place on May 05, 2021 from 1-2 PM and every attendee to the forum will be given the opportunity to submit a qualification of services to be considered for a follow up on-on-one session with the purchasing staff of these medical centers. One-on-one sessions with companies at our past expo events have yielded significant returns for companies in new business contracts.
